

Dear Residents,

Again, the Trailer Storage Lot Committee wishes to extend it's appreciation for all assignees for removing their trailers from the lot by the requested deadline. This really helped for us to get the lot completed.

**Trailers can be placed back into the lot starting this Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup>.**

- Take note of new space assignments (see attachment).
- Trailers cannot exceed an overall width of 10ft. in. Spaces are just shy of 10ft. wide due to the painted line.
- Do not **ever** place your trailer in a space that is not assigned to you!
- If there is a trailer in your space that does not belong to you, please take yours home and contact the Trailer Storage Lot Committee so we get it straighten out. This will cause less confusion.
- Trailers must be centered between the painted lines and not encroach in the spaces on either side of your assigned space.
- Back trailers up as close to fence as possible without hitting it. If you do hit the fence, pull forward and then fix any damage (it is really easy).

The committee is asking all residents with an assigned spot to re-evaluate their storage needs and reply to this message if you **DO NOT REQUIRE YOUR SPACE ASSIGNMENT**. **Spaces cannot and will not be held empty for future use. If you request a space, you must use it! Additionally, at any time of the year your storage needs change, please update the committee as soon as possible.**

**The following space assignment change is effective immediately.**

- If a resident has requested or plans to request a space assignment while researching or procuring a trailer/ boat, their assignment will be made after a confirmed purchase. The committee appreciates your understanding of this change.

The committee continues to evaluate the use of the lot to maximize the space assignments and evaluate the future needs of the community. Help us to accomplish our goals by providing timely communication regarding changes to your trailer storage needs.

\***Note:** lot owners that were assigned a 2<sup>nd</sup> space will have to relinquish it as needed for lot owners that are requesting a first space, if there are none available. Relinquish order will be based on latest request to earliest request.

**All trailers must be removed from homesites by Sunday April 13<sup>th</sup>. If your space is not occupied by April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025 it will be forfeited, you will need to contact the committee to possibly get a new assignment.**
